H.E.R.O. (Hudson Economic Recovery Organization): The goal of the HERO program is to invest one-half cent sales tax funds back into the Hudson economy by providing funding programs to its businesses or organizations. REMINDER: PLEASE DO NOT PUT ANY GREASE DOWN YOUR DRAINS. There has been sewer blockages and lagoon problems because of excess grease in the system. This costs the town money for repairs and in turn costs the residents.

BRUSH PILE KEYS: The brush pile is now locked to keep the grazing cows out and to prevent damage when the road is wet. Please stop by Town Hall during business hours and check out a key before you go.

DID YOU KNOW...Property owners are responsible to make sure their water meter can be read and is accessible. Please remove weeds, animal waste, etc. Per Ordinance, the OWNER of the property is responsible for any damage to the meter and may be charged an additional \$40 fee if your meter is unreadable or inaccessible.

NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS: *Please be considerate of your neighbors. The hot and damp weather really brings out the odors of your dogs' waste. Please clean up after your dogs!* With nicer weather, dogs are spending more time outdoors and we have been receiving more complaints regarding dogs running loose and being aggressive. Please make sure you know where your dog is at all times! It is also required that all animals must have proof of vaccination and a pet license with the Town. If you have more than three (3) dogs, you need an Annual Kennel Permit.

Permits: There are Town Ordinances regarding mobile homes, buildings, fences, etc., so please make sure to read and check on setback permits, mobile home/trailer permits, or home improvements, etc.

Auto Pay for your water/sewer bill: Did you know you can now pay your utility bill by text? Auto pay is also available. Your bill will be paid timely, on a specific day of the month. No more writing a check or stopping by Town Hall to pay before the 20th. If you don't want to use auto pay, you can still sign up to use xpressbillpay and pay online at your convenience. **It's free to sign up and free to use!**
