NOTICES

BRUSH PILE KEYS: The brush pile is now locked to keep the grazing cows out and to prevent damage when the road is wet. Please stop by Town Hall during business hours and check out a key before you go. If anyone has the missing chain and lock, please return it. Replacing it costs the town money.

DID YOU KNOW...Property owners are responsible to make sure their water meter can be read and is accessible. Please remove weeds, animal waste, etc. Per Ordinance, the **OWNER** of the property is responsible for any damage to the meter and may be charged an **ADDITIONAL \$40 FEE** if your meter is unreadable or inaccessible.

NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS: *Please be considerate of your neighbors. Please clean up after your dogs* Please make sure you know where your dog is at all times! It is required that all animals must have proof of vaccination and a pet license with the Town. If you have more than three (3) dogs, you are required to have an Annual Kennel Permit.

Permits: There are Town Ordinances regarding mobile homes, buildings, fences, etc., so please make sure to read and check on setback permits, mobile home/trailer permits, or home improvements, etc.

Auto Pay for your water/sewer bill: Did you know you can now pay your utility bill by text? Auto pay is also available. Your bill will be paid timely, on a specific day of the month. No more writing a

check or stopping by Town Hall to pay before the 20th. If you don't want to use auto pay, you can still sign up to use xpressbillpay and pay online at your convenience. **It's free to sign up and free to use!**
