<u>COMMUNITY FREE BREAD:</u> The bread is **GENERALLY** delivered on Tuesdays. <u>PLEASE STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE</u> <u>UNTIL ALL THE BREAD HAS BEEN SET OUT</u>. This service is not affiliated with Town Hall. We do not know the schedule of when the bread will arrive and we do not have the time to call and let you know it is here. Thank you for understanding.

NOTICES

FERAL CATS — The Town is going to begin trapping the feral cats around town. The Town asks that you NOT feed stray cats. If they don't get food, they will move on and migrate elsewhere. The town will trap them. If you, or someone you know would like some barn cats, please let us know and we will get them delivered. If you have cats that are not licensed with the town and are outside, they will be considered feral and will be trapped. Please make sure your pets are licensed and have a tag. If you would like a trap set near your house, please contact Town Hall. A can of cat food is appreciated for help with the traps.

<u>Winter Water Allowance</u> Beginning December 1st, an allowance of an additional 3,000 gallons will be permitted on your water bill. Please run a trickle of water during freezing weather to prevent frozen pipes. Please continue to check your meter and confirm that it is safe to access for our reader. With the cold weather, please make sure the area is free from ice, snow, or materials piled on, or around your meter. Per Ordinance, the **OWNER** of the property is responsible for making sure their water meter can be read and is accessible and may be charged an <u>ADDITIONAL \$40 FEE</u> if your meter is unreadable or inaccessible.

BRUSH PILE KEYS: The brush pile is now locked to prevent damage and unauthorized dumping. Please stop by Town Hall during business hours and check out a key before you go.

DID YOU KNOW...Property owners are responsible to make sure their water meter can be read and is accessible. Please remove weeds, animal waste, etc. Per Ordinance, the OWNER of the property is responsible for any damage to the meter and may be charged an ADDITIONAL \$40 FEE if your meter is unreadable or inaccessible.

<u>NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS</u>: Please be considerate of your neighbors. Please clean up after your dogs Please make sure you know where your dog is at all times.

<u>Permits:</u> There are Town Ordinances regarding mobile homes, buildings, fences, etc., so please make sure to read and check on setback permits, mobile home/trailer permits, or home improvements, etc.

Auto Pay for your water/sewer bill: Did you know you can now pay your utility bill by text? Auto pay is also available. Your bill will be paid timely, on a specific day of the month. No more writing a check or stopping by Town Hall to pay before the 20th. If you don't want to use auto pay, you can still sign up to use xpressbillpay and pay online at your convenience. It's free to sign up and free to use!
