H.E.R.O. (Hudson Economic Recovery Organization): The goal of the HERO program is to invest the one-half cent sales tax funds back into the Hudson economy. This funding program is awarded to businesses or organizations in Hudson. The HERO committee operates under the Town Council and is made up of three members appointed by the Mayor. The committee will review applications and make recommendations for awards and the Town Council will make the final award decision. NOTICES

REMINDER: Please make sure your meter is accessible by the Town personnel. There is a potential fine associated with blocked/locked gates and meters buried under debris for the personnel that reads your meter each month.

BRUSH PILE KEYS: THE BRUSH PILE IS FOR BRUSH. Household trash or any metal, etc. is NOT allowed. Please don't use the brush pile if the roads are wet. Stop by Town Hall during business hours and check out a key.

Pet licenses are due to be renewed in January.

NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS: Please be considerate of your neighbors. Quiet your dog if it is barking and clean up waste. You must know where your dog is at all times! It is required that all animals have proof of vaccination and a pet license with the Town. If you have more than three (3) dogs, you are required to have an Annual Kennel Permit.

<u>Permits</u>: There are Town Ordinances regarding mobile homes, buildings, fences, etc., so please make sure to read and check on setback permits, mobile home/trailer permits, or home improvements, etc.

Auto Pay for your water/sewer bill: Autopay users: If you get a new debit/credit card, please update your card on Xpressbill.com or call Town Hall. Your payment will stop being paid due to this. Paying your bill can be done by text, phone, and autopay. Your bill will be paid timely, on a specific day of the month. No more writing a check or stopping by Town Hall to pay before the 20th. If

you don't want to use auto pay, you can still sign up to use xpressbillpay and pay online at your convenience. <u>It's free to sign up and free to use!</u>
