MAYOR'S MINUTE

June 2025 Mayor's Minute

Happy Independence Day everyone, I wish you a safe and fun holiday. The public hearing on Hudson's **Level One Water Master Plan** was held on June 18, 2025. Despite the numerous notices in all media in Fremont County, only three residents attended and two were town council members. The presentation included information on four options for the future of Hudson's water and how the town will pay for chosen options. The Water Treatment Plant statutory reserve account and water rates were discussed. On June 25, 2025 Headwaters Economics prepared and submitted a Hazard Mitigation Grant Project application for **Flood Mitigation** for Hudson. We should receive notice within a couple of months if Hudson is granted the funds. The deadline to receive the town's **Sewer Lift Station & Wastewater Lagoon** assessment is extended to the end of August. I am already investigating grant funding options. **Wind River Job Corps** is still on the chopping block; I have not heard of any changes or options for the program and services to continue. However, I am still hopeful. **The Ordinance Committee** (Facebook page is Happenings in Hudson) met on June 19th with more changes to submit to the town council and the attorney. Again, many thanks to the Committee! Many thanks to **Brian, Josh, and Tammy Rohrbacher** for their continued selfless support and dedication, placing **flags along Hudson's Main Street**. Trees will be planted next week at the **Hudson Cemetery** and a dedication ceremony will be held soon to thank and honor the Tony Berce family for their generosity to Hudson's cemetery. The date is to be determined soon. **Mosquito spraying** has started on Thursday evenings. A big thank you to the City of Riverton for helping us. **Svilar Park** benches and the **Gold Star Park** monument platform is scheduled to receive maintenance and repair this summer. I attended the **Wyoming Association of Municipalities conference** in Cheyenne, and I learned and received more information on opportunities to pursue for Hudson. I made several contacts with vendors to investigate more savings regarding our insurance and deposit programs with a higher rate of return. I have attended several meetings for the **Big Corral Ditch** this month. A regular schedule of maintenance is planned for the ditches through town. Letters were mailed to residents affected by this activity. I hope everyone is enjoying their summer!
