MAYOR'S MINUTE

August 2025 Mayor's Minute

Hudson's Level One Water Master Plan: one copy of Hudson's Plan is in the Clerk/Treasurer's office for public review. I am attending a **Flood Mitigation** planning school this week. I hope to get information about our grant application from Homeland Security during the class. Monthly meetings and information sharing continues regarding the **Sewer Lift Station & Wastewater Lagoon** assessment. Meetings with **Wind River Job Corps** are scheduled for the first week of September to discuss installation of our Welcome Sign on the south side of town. **Wayfinding Signs** to Hudson's library, Sivilar Park and the 2nd Street River access are planned with funds from the Wind River Visitor's Council. A committee of three residents will meet in October. **DEQ Brownsfield Program** is working with Hudson to assess the old white theater building on Main Street for removal. Hudson is partnering with the property owners to accomplish this task. The **Hudson Cemetery** has a fresh cemetery map installation. Flags representing the military branches are on order for **Gold Star Park** and the cemetery. The VFW is researching veterans for cemetery identification and markers. The Berce dedication ceremony has been postponed to next Spring to accommodate the trustees' schedules. Meetings continue with the **Corral Ditch** regarding changes and their associated costs. The **Dessie Bebout Post Office dedication ceremony** was an incredible, special ceremony. I enjoyed chatting with the Bebout family members and the dignitaries in attendance. **Library:** the town is soliciting bids to repair the existing library shed/building and present to town council for economic development funds.
