

## ORDINANCE 859

### AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING UTILITY RATES AND FEES WITHIN THE TOWN OF HUDSON AND ADOPTING A UTILITY RATE SCHEDULE; AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR RATE ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

**WHEREAS**, All previous Ordinances or Resolutions setting water and sewer rates, fees, and charges inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed;

**WHEREAS**, The Governing Body of the Town of Hudson recently conducted a Wyoming Water Development Commission Level 1 Water Study and a Preliminary Engineering Report with EPA partners to assess Hudson's Wastewater System. Based on these studies, it was determined that the following rates should be adopted to account for inflation and higher operation and maintenance costs, to restore and maintain the reserves required by Wyoming Statute § 15-7-407, and to cover all operating, maintenance, and depreciation expenses.

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Hudson held a Public Meeting on April 14, 2026, to consider and determine the increases;

**WHEREAS**, The Governing Body of the Town of Hudson has determined that an increase in the utility rates is justified to ensure adequate revenue is generated in order to pay for costs associated with those services rendered.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the Town of Hudson, Fremont County, Wyoming that the Utility Rates be set as follows beginning July 1, 2026:



**IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED**, that the Utility Rates shall continue to be increased every July 1 for the next four (4) years by resolution at the increase rate of Five Dollars (\$5.00) each for Water and Sewer.


This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law and the Ordinance of the Town of Hudson.
